The Role:

The Asset Delivery function within Gas Networks Ireland is responsible for the end-to-end planning, designing and delivery of GNI's portfolio of asset development programmes. Encompassing Project Delivery Management and Design Delivery; the Asset Delivery function brings together all the technical and project support capabilities needed to take high-level

projects and programmes from the Portfolio Office and translate these through from detailed design and project planning to construction delivery and handover to Asset Operations.

Reporting to the Pipelines Lead, the Pipelines GIS Technician will work on aspects of pipeline liner assets for Dx and occasionally Tx, inclusive of capturing assets within the digital software used to record assets (GIS, ESRI etc.) The role requires producing maps to facilitate the needs of our colleagues and customers, e.g. wayleave maps, design drawing etc. The Pipeline GIS Technician will work within a team of skilled Project GIS Specialists supporting the Project Delivery process within Digital Design Services.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work within a team of multi disciplined CAD/GIS / Mapping technicians
- Maintain a close working relationship with the Project Delivery Engineers.
- Support the production and recording of linear assets in a timely manner.
- Attend project meetings, assisting with project information.
- Assist and support in maintaining the integrity of data quality in GIS. Ensure that proper procedures are followed for issuing of both hard copy and digital data to external bodies in accordance with Dial Before You Dig agreed procedure.
- Assisting Design Engineers in the planning, design and programming of significant Network Development Projects from conception through to construction completion.
- Supporting Pipeline Lead as required to meet project design requirements utilizing the outsourced Engineering Service Providers.
- Support the efficient production of relevant drawings, e.g. Standard drawings, PDFs, wayleaves etcetera.
- Support the coordinating the implementation of new systems and controls to support Digital Design Services in line with best practice, e.g. ISO9000.
- Support developing and implementing initiatives to enhance the functionality and operation of Digital Services.
- Supporting Land and Consent Management where wayleaves are required.
- Produce maps to support network outages as required.
- Other duties may be assigned from time to time.

Knowledge, Skills and Experience:

- Proven technical competence is essential – Level 6 qualification degree or other relevant qualification desirable with a minimum of 3 years relevant experience, preferably in the natural gas or similar industry.
- Strong technical knowledge of Geographical Information System is required.
- Have an awareness of H&S standards, Operational Procedures Manual, Engineering Design process etc.
- Have an awareness of relevant Gas Standards, Codes of Practice and Statutory Requirements would be desirable.
- You will be a strong team player and have a demonstrated ability to bring teams together.
- You will be a natural collaborator seeking out opportunities to share knowledge and improve Results
- You are comfortable with change and have a demonstrated ability to identify opportunities for improvements and efficiency
- You have demonstrated a commitment to developing new skills in yourself and others.
